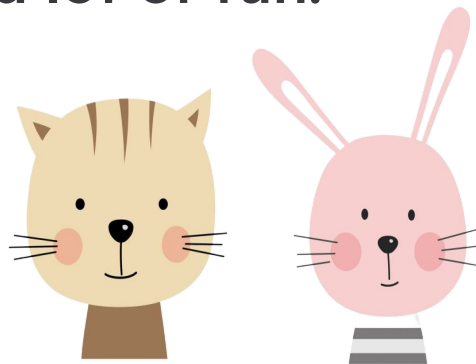


A PICNIC WITH FRIENDS
