

# DIAMONDS AND SPIDERS

Play this fun game with your friends or family!

Rules and steps:

- 1 Begin with picking a player of your choice.
- 2 You can take a printout of everything given in the next sheet, draw your own or use your own pawn from another board game.
- 3 Roll a dice or simply close your eyes and count to 6 until the other opponent asks you to start and stop.
- 4 A player can start the game only if they get 6 or 1.
- 5 In this game, there are two main things, namely the spiders and the diamonds. Whoever collects more diamonds and reaches the last box wins the game.
- 6 If you are able to do the action described in the tile you land on, you collect a diamond.
- 7 If you are unable to do the action, you have to pick a spider and move one step back.
- 8 You can take printouts of the diamonds and spiders or even make your own.
