In some of the earliest uses, it is described as an East Indian sauce made with fruits and spices, spelled “*catchup*.”

This word comes from the Old English for “day’s eye,” as the flowers open during the day and shut again at night.

Derived from the Sanskrit root *chapati*, the word initially referred to any type of pressing, kneading, or soothing.

This word comes from the Caribbean word “barbacoa,” meaning “frame of sticks.”

The word finds its origin in the similarity between the shape of biceps and calves to a mice running under the skin.

The Latin word *peculium* meant “private property.” The current meaning of this word (unusual) surfaced after the term evolved to mean “distinguished, or special.”
