Rules and Steps:

- 1 Choose the mystery you want to solve. You can also choose the setting according to the story you want to write.
- 2 Some clues are also given, which will help you build the story.
- 3 Pick the characters of your choice. There have to be at least two suspects and one detective.
- 4 You are all set to write your story. Remember to mention the reason behind committing the crime.
- 5 Also, mention evidence so that the readers can identify the culprit.
- 6 You can take printouts of the sheets and use them to write a story or even make your own.
- 7 Read out the story to your friends or family and let them guess the culprit.



MYSTERY (Pick any 1)

- 1 You left a block of cheese on the table. You come back to find that the cheese is missing. You remember your brother saying that he was hungry. You also notice the cheese crumbs leading to a rat hole.
- 2 You go to a birthday party and discover that someone has eaten the entire cake.
- 3 Someone has stolen your notes.
- 4 While your neighbor was not home, someone stole a diamond necklace from their house.

CLUES

cheese crumbs leading to a rat hole, cheese block found in your brother's room, footprints of a dog, footprints of a person, your friend's handkerchief on your table

- 1 Friend's birthday party
- 2 Your own house
- 3 Your classroom
- 4 Your neighborhood

CHARACTERS

Mr. Roger: the detective

Gabriel: the chef

Robin: the thief

Mellow: the mouse

George, Amy, Jacob, Olivia, Mrs. Smith: other characters
