Frogs are members of the amphibian family. An amphibian lives some of its life on water and some of its life on land. You can find frogs almost anywhere except for the cold continent of Antarctica. Most of the world's frogs are normally found in tropical regions and warmer countries. If a frog does live in a colder climate, it will hibernate buried deep in burrows or in mud deep at the bottom of ponds. A frog's body temperature is the same as the surrounding area where the frog is. This makes them cold-blooded animals.

Frogs have webbed feet that help them swim. Some frogs such as tree frogs have tiny sticky pads on their fingers and toes to help them climb up high. Frogs can leap great distances thanks to their strong hind legs.

Frogs enjoy eating things like insects, worms, and spiders. Some have a sticky tongue that they use to catch their prey.

Breathing for frogs can either be done using their lungs or through their skin. They have a special ability to absorb water through their skin so they do not have to drink it like other animals.
