Use a comma to separate an introductory clause or phrase from the rest of the sentence. Rule 1 Example: Actually, all of us are going on a picnic. Question tags are added at the end of Rule 2 sentences to ask for confirmation or agreement when we are unsure. Example: Your brother is in the army, isn't he? Use a comma to set off the words "yes" and Rule 3 "no." Example: Yes, I'd like to drink orange juice. When addressing a person or thing directly, the Rule 4 name used must be separated with a comma. Example: Are you tired, Carl?
