PROCESS WRITING

Here's an example of the process to make invisible ink. Read it carefully, and then write the process of making your favorite sandwich.

MATERIALS: Paper, a bowl, hot water, salt, cotton swab (or something to apply the ink, like an old paintbrush, regular pencil)

- 1. First, pour hot water into a bowl.
- 2. Gradually add salt, and mix until the salt has completely dissolved. Do this as many times as possible until the salt no longer dissolves. (This is called a saturated solution.).
- 3. Then, using a cotton swab or something similar, write or draw out your message on a piece of paper. While the ink is still wet, you'll be able to see what you're doing.
- 4. Now, let the paper dry completely; now the ink should truly be invisible!
- 5. In the end, lightly run the side of a pencil across the paper. You should find that where the invisible ink is, the pencil lead looks darker, letting you see the message!
