- 7 At a summer festival, Mike ate 4 corn dogs, 3 cotton candies, and 1 funnel cake. How many food items did he eat in total?
- 8 During a summer vacation, Sarah read 3 adventure books, 2 mystery books, and 1 fantasy book. How many books did she read in total?
