

Solve the following word problems.

- John has 3 snowballs, he makes 2 more and his friend gives him another 4. How many snowballs does John have now?
- 2 Anna finds 2 icicles outside, then she finds 3 more in the backyard and 1 more on the porch. How many icicles does Anna have in total?
- On Monday, it snowed 2 inches. On Tuesday, it snowed another 4 inches and on Wednesday, it snowed 2 inches. How many inches did it snow in total?
- You have 2 winter hats, 3 scarves, and 2 pair of gloves. How many winter items do you have in total?
- 5 There are 3 snowmen in the park. 2 more are built by children and another 3 by adults. How many snowmen are there in the park now?
- 6 Sally has 2 pairs of mittens, she finds 1 more pair in her closet and her mom gives her another 4 pairs. How many pairs of mittens does Sally have now?
- 7 There are 3 reindeer in the field. 1 more join them and then another 2. How many reindeer are there in the field now?
- John decorates his Christmas tree with 2 red baubles, 4 blue baubles and 3 gold baubles. How many baubles has he used in total?
