- 6 For the Thanksgiving potluck, 15 people brought turkey, 28 people brought sides, and 9 people brought desserts. How many people brought food?
- 7 At the Thanksgiving Day football game, 45 people cheered for team A, 35 people cheered for team B, and 18 people were neutral. How many people were at the game in total?
