Solve the following word problems.

1 Santa Claus has 300 candy canes. He gets 200 more from an elf and another 100 from Mrs. Claus. How many candy canes does Santa have in total?

2 There are 250 red Christmas lights, 350 green Christmas lights, and 150 white Christmas lights on a tree. How many Christmas lights are there in total on the tree?

3 In a Christmas party, 300 cookies, 100 cupcakes, and 100 slices of cake were served. How many desserts were served in total?

4 A boy receives 300 dollars from his parents, 250 dollars from his grandparents, and 300 dollars from his uncle for Christmas. How much money does he receive in total?

5 On Christmas Eve, 400 children visited Santa's village in the morning, 330 in the afternoon, and 200 in the evening. How many children visited Santa's village on Christmas Eve?

6 A Christmas charity event raised 500 dollars from a bake sale, 200 dollars from a carol singing event, and 100 dollars from a raffle draw. How much money was raised in total?

7 A store sold 100 Christmas trees on Monday, 200 on Tuesday, and 100 on Wednesday. How many Christmas trees did the store sell in total?
