3 Mary is making a large batch of soup. She uses 2,000 pints of water, 1,500 pints of chicken broth, and 500 pints of cream. How many pints of liquid does she use in total?

4 A restaurant used 3,500 pounds of vegetables, 2,000 pounds of meat, and 500 pounds of grains in a week. How many pounds of food did the restaurant use in total?

5 Chef Lisa has 2,500 ounces of chocolate. She bought 1,500 ounces more. Later, she received another 1,000 ounces from her supplier. How much chocolate does she have now in total?

6 In a coffee shop, there are 3,500 cups of coffee beans, 2,500 cups of milk, and 1,000 cups of sugar. How many cups of ingredients are there in total?

7 Mike is making a large batch of lemonade. He uses 2,000 pints of water, 1,500 pints of lemon juice, and 500 pints of sugar syrup. How many pints of liquid does he use in total?
