- The Christmas tree is 15.75 yards tall. The star on top is 0.25 yards tall. After placing the star, the tree's height increased by 0.5 yards due to the snow. How tall is the Christmas tree now?
- Rudolph has 9.99 lb of carrots and 4.44 lb of apples for his Christmas meal. He ate 3.33 lb of carrots How much food does Rudolph have left?
- 4 Santa's sleigh can hold 50.00 lb of gifts. He has already loaded 25.25 lb of gifts. After loading another 12.12 lb of gifts, how much more can he load onto his sleigh?
- Mrs. Claus baked 10.00 lb of cookies. She gave 3.33 lb to the elves and 2.22 lb to Santa. How many lb of cookies does Mrs. Claus have left?
- 6 A candy factory produced 250.5 lb of candy canes. They shipped 100.25 lb to the first store and 75.35 lb to the second store. How many pounds of candy canes does the candy factory have left?
- 7 The elves used 15.15 yards of wrapping paper for the gifts. They used another 10.10 yards for the bigger gifts. If they started with 30.00 yards of wrapping paper, how much do they have left?
