5 Emma has 6 onions. She uses 4 onions to make a salad and then buys 5 more onions from the store. How many onions does Emma have now?

6 Mike has 9 tomatoes. He uses 5 tomatoes to make sauce and then his sister gives him 1 more. How many tomatoes does Mike have now?

7 Lily has 2 cucumbers. She buys 7 more cucumbers and then gives 3 cucumbers to her neighbor. How many cucumbers does Lily have now?

8 Jack has 4 bananas. He eats 1 banana and then his grandma gives him 5 more. How many bananas does Jack have now?
