Easter Addition and Subtraction

Solve the following word problems.

1 Peter has 5 chocolate eggs. His friend gives him 2 more. Later, he eats 3 of them. How many chocolate eggs does Peter have now?

2 Emma finds 4 Easter eggs during an egg hunt. She finds 3 more in the garden, but then she gives 2 to her brother. How many Easter eggs does Emma have now?

3 Lucy has 7 jelly beans. Her friend gives her 2 more. Later, she eats 5 of them. How many jelly beans does Lucy have now?

4 Tom finds 6 Easter eggs during an egg hunt. He finds 2 more under the couch, but then his dog eats 3 of them. How many Easter eggs does Tom have now?

5 Sally has 8 chocolate bunnies. Her friend gives her 1 more. Later, she eats 6 of them. How many chocolate bunnies does Sally have now?

6 Mike finds 5 Easter eggs during an egg hunt. He finds 4 more in the park, but then he gives 3 to his sister. How many Easter eggs does Mike have now?

7 Lily has 6 jelly beans. Her friend gives her 3 more. Later, she eats 4 of them. How many jelly beans does Lily have now?
