- During a summer picnic, Lily picked 5 apples and 3 oranges. Later, she ate 2 apples. How many fruits does Lily have left?
- 2 At a summer camp, there were 7 kids playing in the pool and 3 kids playing in the sand. After a while, 2 kids from the pool left for lunch. How many kids are still playing?
- In a summer game, Tom scored 4 points in the first round and 3 points in the second round. During the third round, he lost 2 points. How many points does Tom have now?
- During a summer trip, Emma collected 6 seashells on the first day and 4 seashells on the second day. She gave 3 seashells to her friend. How many seashells does Emma have now?
- At a summer fair, Jack won 5 balloons in a game and 2 balloons in a race. He gave 4 balloons to his little sister. How many balloons does Jack have left?
- During a summer vacation, Mia got 3 books from the library in the first week and 4 books in the second week. She returned 5 books to the library. How many books does Mia have now?
- In a summer garden, there were 8 butterflies and 2 bees. After a while, 3 butterflies flew away. How many insects are now in the garden?
