

Winter Addition and Subtraction

Solve the following word problems.

- 1 There were 4 snow angels in the yard. The kids made 3 more, but 2 got ruined when the dog ran through them. How many snow angels are left in the yard?
- John has 8 snowflakes stickers. He gave 3 to his friend and then his mom gave him 2 more. How many snowflakes stickers does John have now?
- Jack built 5 snowmen in the morning. Then, he built 3 more in the afternoon but accidentally knocked down 2. How many snowmen are standing now?
- 4 Sarah had 7 pairs of mittens. She gave 2 pairs to her friends and then received 4 more as a gift. How many pairs of mittens does she have now?
- Jack found 9 pinecones. He painted 3 of them blue and 4 of them red. How many pinecones were not painted?
- 6 Mark had 10 icicles hanging from his roof. After a strong wind, 3 icicles broke off. Later, 2 more formed. How many icicles are hanging now?
- At a skating rink, there were 8 pairs of skates available. If 2 more pairs were brought in but then 5 were rented out, how many pairs of skates are left at the rink?
