- Santa has 45 candy canes. He gives 15 candy canes to his elves and then he finds another 25 candy canes. How many candy canes does Santa have now?
- 2 A Christmas tree has 50 ornaments. 15 ornaments fell off and 10 more were added. How many ornaments are on the Christmas tree now?
- Rudolph has 35 presents to deliver. He delivers 15 presents in the morning. After lunch, he delivers some more presents and only has 10 left. How many presents did Rudolph deliver after lunch?
- 4 On Christmas Eve, Santa had 60 lights in his sack. He delivered 25 lights and then elves added 15 more lights. How many lights does Santa have now?
- 5 Santa's sack can hold 80 toys. He already put 30 toys in the sack. Then he adds another 25 toys. How many more toys can Santa put in his sack?
- 6 A Christmas tree farm had 100 trees. 40 trees were sold and 10 more were planted. How many trees are there on the farm now?
- 7 Santa has 65 cookies. He eats 20 cookies in the morning and then he eats some more in the afternoon. Now he only has 15 cookies left. How many cookies did Santa eat in the afternoon?
