

Summer Addition and Subtraction

Solve the following word problems.

1 Liam has 35 seashells and he found 22 more at the beach. He then gave some to his friend and was left with 41 seashells. How many seashells did he give to his friend?

2 In a summer camp, there were 56 kids. 23 more kids joined the camp later. But then, 15 kids had to leave the camp early. How many kids are left in the camp now?

3 A summer fruit stall had 59 watermelons. During the day, 18 watermelons were sold. The stall received a shipment of 36 more watermelons. How many watermelons are there at the stall now?

4 Ethan had 60 beach balls at his store. Later, he got 25 more. He then sold some of them and was left with 70 beach balls. How many beach balls did he sell?

5 Ava made 40 ice creams. She sold 14 of them. Later, she made 19 more. How many ice creams does Ava have left?

6 At the beginning of summer, a library had 75 books. During the summer, they bought 15 more books. However, some books were borrowed and now there are 65 books left. How many books were borrowed?
