



Cooking Addition and Subtraction



Solve the following word problems.

1 John has 2,500 ounces of flour. He uses 1,200 ounces to bake some bread and 700 ounces to bake cookies. How much flour does he have left?

2 Emma has 3,000 pints of milk. She uses 1,500 pints to make cheese and gives 800 pints to her neighbor. How many pints of milk does she have left?

3 Tom has 4,000 pounds of sugar. He uses 2,000 pounds to make candy and 1,000 pounds to make cakes. How many pounds of sugar does he have left?

4 Samantha has 5,000 ounces of butter. She uses 2,500 ounces to make pastries and 1,500 ounces to make cookies. How many ounces of butter does she have left?

5 In a bakery, there are 5,000 cupcakes. In the morning, they sold 2,300 cupcakes and in the afternoon, they made another 1,200 cupcakes. How many cupcakes are there in the bakery now?

6 A restaurant had 3,000 grams of pasta. They used 1,200 grams for lunch and 700 grams for dinner. The next day, they bought another 2,000 grams. How many grams of pasta does the restaurant have now?
