Solve the following word problems.

- 1 Mike has 8,000 dollars for his trip. He spends 3,500 dollars on the first week and 2,000 dollars on the second week. How much money does he have left?
- 2 Samantha has saved \$4,500 for her dream vacation. She spends \$2,100 on flight tickets and \$1,200 on hotel bookings. How much money does she have left?
- A travel company has 5,000 customers last year. This year, they gained 3,000 new customers but lost 1,500 old customers. How many customers do they have this year?
- A cruise ship has a capacity of 10,000 people. Currently, there are 6,500 people on board. How many more people can the cruise ship take?
- A family is planning a cross-country road trip. The total distance is 8,000 miles. They plan to drive 3,500 miles the first week and 2,500 miles the second week. How many miles will they have left to drive in the third week?
- A tourist bus can carry up to 7,000 kg. The weight of the passengers is 4,500 kg and their luggage weighs 2,000 kg. How much more weight can the bus carry?
