



Solve the following word problems.

- Peter has 10 Easter eggs. He gave 3 of his Easter eggs to his sister. Later, he found 5 more in the garden. How many Easter eggs does Peter have now?
- 2 Emma has 7 chocolate bunnies for Easter. Her friends gave her 4 more. After eating some, she has 6 left. How many chocolate bunnies did Emma eat?
- There are 15 Easter eggs in a basket. 6 are blue, the rest are pink. After some kids took 4 pink eggs, how many pink eggs are left in the basket?
- John found 8 Easter eggs in the morning. He found 7 more in the afternoon but lost 2 when he was playing. How many Easter eggs does John have now?
- 5 There were 20 Easter eggs in a basket. 7 were taken by kids and 5 more were added later. How many Easter eggs are in the basket now?
- 6 Emily found 12 Easter eggs and her brother found 7. They lost 4 eggs. How many Easter eggs does her brother have now?
- 7 Lucy found 8 Easter eggs in the morning. In the afternoon, she found 7 more. But she lost 2 of them while playing. How many Easter eggs does Lucy have now?
