

Halloween Addition and Subtraction

Solve the following word problems.

- 1 On halloween night, Sarah collected 15 candies. She ate 7 candies at night, and the next morning, she received 3 more from her father. How many candies does Sarah have now?

- 2 John has 20 halloween stickers. He gave 8 stickers to his friend, and then he found 5 more stickers. How many stickers does John have now?

- 3 Lucy has 10 halloween cupcakes. She ate 3 cupcakes and then baked 2 more cupcakes. How many cupcakes does Lucy have now?

- 4 Emma has 18 halloween cookies. She ate 6 cookies and then baked 8 more cookies. How many cookies does Emma have now?

- 5 There are 20 pumpkins in a halloween store. 8 pumpkins were sold in the morning, and then 3 pumpkins were returned to the store. How many pumpkins are there in the store now?

- 6 Mike bought 15 halloween balloons. He received 4 more balloons from his friends, and then 2 balloons popped. How many balloons does Mike have now?

- 7 At a halloween party, there were 20 guests. 7 guests left early, and then 3 more guests joined the party. How many guests are at the party now?
