

Summer Addition and Subtraction

Solve the following word problems.

1 John collected 7 seashells on the beach in the morning. In the afternoon, he collected 6 more. He gave away 3 seashells to his sister. How many seashells does John have now?

2 Sarah had 15 ice creams to sell at the summer fair. She sold 7 ice creams in the morning and 5 in the afternoon. How many ice creams does Sarah have left to sell?

3 Tom caught 9 fish in the morning. In the afternoon, he caught 4 more but 2 escaped from the bucket. How many fish does Tom have now?

4 At summer camp, there were 10 kids in the morning. In the afternoon, 7 more kids joined but 3 kids went home. How many kids are at the camp now?

5 Emma bought 8 popsicles. She ate 2 popsicles and gave away 5 to her friends. How many popsicles does Emma have now?

6 At the beach, there were 15 sandcastles. 5 got washed away by the waves and kids built 4 more. How many sandcastles are there now on the beach?

7 Billy found 10 seashells on Monday and 6 on Tuesday. He lost 3 of them while playing. How many seashells does Billy have now?
