

Winter Addition and Subtraction

Solve the following word problems.

- 1 There were 12 children playing in the snow. If 7 more joined them and then 5 went inside, how many children are playing outside now?
- 2 Sarah bought 10 ornaments for her tree. Then, she bought 5 more but decided to give away 4. How many ornaments does she have now?
- Mark had 18 candy canes. He gave 6 to his friends and then received 4 more as a gift. How many candy canes does Mark have now?
- 4 Lisa had 12 pinecones in her basket. She added 6 more but then used 8 for a craft project. How many pinecones does she have left?
- In a winter theme party, there were 11 cups of hot cocoa. If 8 more were prepared but then 3 were spilled, how many cups are available?
- 6 During a snowstorm, 20 inches of snow fell. If 12 inches melted by the next morning and then 6 more fell, how many inches of snow were there?
- Jacob has 14 snowmen in his yard. 2 melt, and then he builds 5 more. How many snowmen are in Jacob's yard now?
- 8 Lily has 16 pieces of winter-themed stickers. She uses 7 for her art project and then her friend gives her 3 more. How many stickers does Lily have now?
