- John purchased 2.5 pounds of salt to melt the ice on his driveway. Later, he bought an additional 1.2 pounds. How much salt did John purchase in total?
- 2 A store sold 6.4 feet of garland on Monday and 7.2 feet on Wednesday. What was the total length of the garland sold?
- Tom has 4.5 feet of Christmas lights. He buys another 2.3 feet. How many feet of Christmas lights does Tom have now?
- 4 Emily bought 3.7 yards of ribbon for her winter wreaths. Later, she purchased 2.4 yards more. How many yards of ribbon does Emily have in total?
- 5 A snowman was 1.2 feet tall. After a snowfall, it grew by 0.7 feet. How tall is the snowman now?
- 6 A ski resort received 3.5 inches of snow in the morning. It received another 1.6 inches in the afternoon. How much snow did the ski resort receive in total?
- 7 A store sold 4.2 pounds of candy canes in the morning. In the afternoon, they sold another 2.7 pounds. How many pounds of candy canes did the store sell in total?
