

Winter Addition or Subtraction

Solve the following word problems.

- John bought a winter jacket for \$45.6 and a pair of gloves for \$12.3. How much did he spend in total?
- 2 Sarah made \$25.4 by selling handmade scarves. She spent \$15.7 on supplies. How much profit did she make?
- Jack used 12.5 gallons of antifreeze in his car and his brother's car used 7.3 gallons more. How many gallons of antifreeze were used in total?
- A store sold 45.7 pounds of salt on Monday and 30.2 pounds on Tuesday. How many pounds of salt did the store sell in total?
- 5 Emma had \$50. She spent \$23.6 on a winter hat and scarf. How much money does she have left?
- 6 A ski resort received 15.6 inches of snow on Saturday and 10.7 inches on Sunday. How much snow did the resort receive in total?
- 7 A winter coat costs 45.6 dollars. During a sale, the price of the coat was reduced by 15.7 dollars. How much does the coat cost after the reduction?
- A store sold 35.4 pounds of firewood on Friday and 25.7 pounds less on Saturday. How many pounds of firewood did the store sell on Saturday?
