Solve the following word problems.

- 1 Mike used 2.20 kg of flour for baking bread and 1.75 kg for cookies. How much flour did he use in total?
- Sara bought 4.50 kg of apples. She used 2.25 kg for making apple pie. How many kg of apples does she have left?
- Daniel has 3.75 liters of cooking oil. He used 1.50 liters for frying fish. How much cooking oil is left?
- 4 Linda used 1.85 kg of sugar for making candies and 2.15 kg for baking a cake. How much sugar did she use in total?
- Tom has 5.00 kg of potatoes. He used 2.75 kg for making french fries. How many kg of potatoes does he have left?
- Anna used 1.65 liters of milk for making pudding and 1.35 liters for making a smoothie. How much milk did she use in total?
- Peter has 4.50 liters of orange juice. He drank 2.25 liters. How much orange juice is left?
- 8 Laura used 2.75 kg of flour for baking bread and 1.25 kg for making pasta. How much flour did she use in total?
- 9 Amy has 2.65 gallons of lemonade. She drinks 1.25 gallons. How much lemonade does she have left?
