- 6 A summer camp charges \$150.50 for a week. If a discount of \$30.45 is given, how much does it cost now?
- 7 At a summer picnic, a watermelon costs \$6.50 and a pack of hot dogs costs \$4.75. How much do they cost altogether?
- A family's summer vacation costs \$500.25. They have already paid \$200.75. How much more do they need to pay?
