## Solve the following word problems.

- John has 3.75 gallons of milk. He uses 2.5 gallons to make cheese. How many gallons of milk does he have left?
- 2 Emma baked a cake that weighs 2.45 pounds. She ate 0.95 pounds of it. How much cake is left?
- Maria used 2.45 kg of flour and 3.75 kg of sugar for baking. How much ingredients did she use in total?
- 4 Lisa has 5.5 pints of cream. She uses 2.25 pints to make butter. How many pints of cream does she have left?
- John used 1.25 liters of milk and 2.50 liters of water in his recipe. How much liquid did he use in total?
- 6 Sarah has 7.5 gallons of apple juice. She drinks 2.75 gallons. How many gallons of apple juice does she have left?
- 7 Tom has 8.25 pounds of sugar. He uses 3.75 pounds for baking. How many pounds of sugar does he have left?
- 8 Emma used 0.55 kg of butter and 1.45 kg of chocolate to make a cake. How much did these ingredients weigh in total?
- 9 Robert has 10.75 ounces of cheese. He eats 5.25 ounces. How many ounces of cheese does he have left?
