- John has 75 ounces of flour. He uses 35 ounces to bake a cake. How many ounces of flour does he have left?
- 2 Emily has 30 eggs in her fridge. She uses 12 eggs to make a cake. How many eggs does she have left?
- 3 Emma has 50 carrots. She buys 30 more at the store. How many carrots does Emma have now?
- 4 Mike has 45 pounds of sugar. He bought an additional 25 pounds. How much sugar does he have now?
- 5 Lisa has 80 pints of ice cream. She sold 30 pints. How many pints of ice cream does she have left?
- Tom has 50 ounces of chocolate. He eats 20 ounces. How many ounces of chocolate does he have left?
- 7 Tim has 40 oranges. He buys 50 more at the market. How many oranges does Tim have now?
- Jack has 40 cups of rice. He cooks 15 cups for dinner. How many cups of rice does he have left?
- 9 Sophia has 70 ounces of butter. She uses 30 ounces to bake a pie. How many ounces of butter does she have left?
