

Summer Addition or Subtraction

Solve the following word problems.

1 In the summer camp, there were 78 children. 18 more children joined the camp. How many children are there now in the camp?

2 Sara collected 65 seashells at the beach. She lost 27 of them. How many seashells does Sara have now?

3 John made 56 ice creams. He sold 34 of them on a hot summer day. How many ice creams does John have left?

4 In a summer fair, there were 92 balloons. 28 balloons popped. How many balloons are left?

5 There were about 33 birds in the park. 25 more birds came to the park. How many birds are there now in the park?

6 Emma bought 90 water balloons for a summer party. She used 36 of them. How many water balloons does Emma have left?

7 There were 70 people at the beach. 20 more people came to the beach. How many people are there now at the beach?

8 A summer camp had 88 participants. 32 of them left the camp early. How many participants are left in the camp?
