Solve the following word problems.

- 1 In a school's summer camp, 650 kids are already registered. If 200 more kids register, how many kids will be in the camp?

- 2 A beach store has 300 umbrellas. If the store sold 159 umbrellas on the first day of June, how many umbrellas are still unsold?

- 3 A water park has 512 visitors in the morning. If 237 more visitors come in the afternoon, how many visitors are there in total?

- 4 In a summer fruit market, there are 215 watermelons. If 119 watermelons are sold, how many watermelons are left?

- 5 A summer fair has 880 visitors. If 315 visitors leave before the fair ends, how many visitors are left?

- 6 A summer fair was decorated with 800 balloons. 359 balloons popped due to the heat. How many balloons were left?

- 7 A summer ice cream shop had 214 vanilla ice creams and 567 chocolate ice creams. How many ice creams were there in total?

- 8 A water park has 612 visitors in the morning. If 211 more visitors come in the afternoon, how many visitors are there in total?
