

Winter Addition or Subtraction

Solve the following word problems.

1 Emma went ice skating for 180 minutes on Monday and then 108 minutes on Tuesday. How many minutes did Emma skate in total?

2 A winter carnival had 350 visitors in the morning and 450 more in the afternoon. How many visitors did the carnival have in total?

3 A sledding hill has 534 sleds. 276 of them were used. How many sleds are left on the hill?

4 The winter fair sold 375 tickets on Monday and 452 tickets on Tuesday. How many tickets did the winter fair sell in these two days?

5 A snow fort was built with 723 snow blocks. 254 of them were destroyed in a snowball fight. How many snow blocks are left in the fort?

6 Jack took 756 steps to reach the top of the snowy hill. If the hill had an additional 120 steps, how many steps would it have in total?

7 A store had 754 winter hats. They sold 350 hats. How many hats does the store have now?

8 A family used 434 logs for the fireplace in December and 256 logs in January. How many logs did the family use in total?
