

## **Cooking Addition or Subtraction**

Solve the following word problems.

- 1 John has 6,500 ounces of flour in his bakery. He uses 2,300 ounces to bake some bread. How many ounces of flour does he have left?
- 2 A restaurant used 2,356 pounds of flour in one day and 3,456 pounds the next day. How many pounds of flour were used in total?
- 3 A restaurant has 8,000 ounces of cooking oil. After frying some food, they are left with 3,450 ounces. How many ounces of oil did they use?
- 4 Sarah bought 5,678 grams of sugar. She used 2,345 grams for baking cookies. How much sugar does she have left?
- 5 A grocery store has 10,000 pounds of potatoes. After selling some, they are left with 7,250 pounds. How many pounds of potatoes did they sell?
- 6 A pizza shop sold 3,875 pizzas in January and 4,125 pizzas in February. How many pizzas did they sell in total?
- A bakery has 9,000 pounds of butter. After making some pastries, they are left with 6,500 pounds.
  How many pounds of butter did they use?
- 8 In a cooking competition, 3,250 dishes were prepared in the first round. In the second round, 2,750 more dishes were prepared than in the first round. How many dishes were prepared in total?
