6 Lisa has 4 gallons of water. She uses 2 gallons for cooking. How many gallons of water does she have left?

7 Tom has 6 pints of cream. He needs 15 pints in total for a recipe. How many more pints does he need to get?

8 Emma has 8 cups of rice. She uses 5 cups for dinner. How many cups of rice does she have left?

9 Harry has 10 ounces of cheese. He uses 7 ounces for a pizza. How many ounces of cheese does he have left?
