

Winter Addition or Subtraction

Solve the following word problems.

- In a snowball-making contest, Tim made 12 snowballs, and then he made 8 more. How many snowballs did Tim make in total?
- 2 There were 12 pairs of ice skates in the store. 6 more pairs arrived. How many pairs of ice skates are there in total?
- 3 A sled can carry 15 snowballs. If it already has 9 snowballs, how many more can it carry?
- There are 17 penguins on the ice. 5 of them slide into the water. How many penguins are left on the ice?
- There were 11 kids on the sledding hill. 4 more kids joined them. How many kids are on the hill now?
- 6 Sarah had 20 cups of hot cocoa. She served 7 to her friends. How many cups of hot cocoa does she have left?
- 7 Tom has 6 pairs of winter gloves. He buys 7 more pairs. How many pairs of winter gloves does Tom have now?
- Anna has 18 snowflakes in her collection. She loses 10 of them. How many snowflakes does Anna have left?
- 9 Sam has 7 winter hats. He buys 4 more. How many winter hats does Sam have now?
