Solve the following word problems.

1 In one nest, there are 2 fluffy chicks. In another nest, there are 5 chicks. How many chicks are there in total?

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- 2 Emily painted 5 Easter eggs. Her brother painted 2 more. How many Easter eggs did they paint in total?
- Jacob has 6 Easter candies. His friend gave him 3 more. How many Easter candies does Jacob have now?
- 4 In an Easter egg hunt, Sophie found 4 eggs and her sister found 6 eggs. How many eggs did they find in total?
- 5 Oliver bought 2 Easter bunnies and 7 Easter eggs. How many items did Oliver buy in total?
- 6 In an Easter party, 4 children were wearing bunny ears and 4 children were wearing chick costumes. How many children were in costumes?
- 7 Emma has 3 Easter baskets. She bought 6 more. How many Easter baskets does Emma have now?
- 8 Lucas found 5 Easter candies in the garden. His sister gave him 2 more. How many Easter candies does Lucas have now?
