

Solve the following word problems.

- 1 Liam has 4 sleds. He gets 2 more for his birthday. How many sleds does Liam have now?
- 2 Tommy has 4 winter hats. He buys 3 more. How many winter hats does Tommy have now?
- There are 2 snowmen in the yard. The kids build 5 more. How many snowmen are in the yard now?
- 4 Lucy has 5 icicles hanging from her house. She finds 3 more. How many icicles does Lucy have now?
- Oliver has 3 pairs of mittens. His grandmother knits him 4 more pairs. How many pairs of mittens does Oliver have now?
- There are 6 snowflakes on the window. 3 more snowflakes land on the window. How many snowflakes are on the window now?
- 7 Sammy has 2 cups of hot chocolate. If he makes 3 more cups, how many cups of hot chocolate will he have?
- 8 There are 3 penguins on the ice. 3 more penguins join them. How many penguins are on the ice now?
- There are 2 kids playing on the ice rink. If 6 more kids join them, how many kids are playing on the ice rink now?
