3 Lucy sold 48 cups of lemonade on Saturday and 51 cups on Sunday at her summer lemonade stand. How many cups of lemonade did she sell in total?

4 On a summer trip, Mike visited 20 beaches in California and 35 beaches in Florida. How many beaches did Mike visit in total?

5 During a summer picnic, 15 people brought sandwiches and 25 people brought salads. How many people brought food?

6 In a summer reading challenge, Amy read 30 books in June and 40 books in July. How many books did Amy read in total?

7 At a summer festival, there are 22 ice cream stands and 33 lemonade stands. How many stands are there in total?

8 During a summer vacation, Tom collected 28 seashells at the beach and 42 pebbles at the river. How many items did Tom collect in total?
