- 2 Sarah has 5 friends coming for Thanksgiving dinner and she invited 9 more friends. How many friends did she invite in total?

- 3 There were 6 pumpkins on the table and 10 more in the kitchen. How many pumpkins are there in total?

- 4 Tom has 10 guests for Thanksgiving dinner and his brother invited 3 more. How many guests are there in total?

- 5 If there are 7 people at the Thanksgiving table and 5 more join, how many people are at the table?

- 6 A family ate 9 slices of turkey and then ate 6 more. How many slices of turkey did they eat in total?

- 7 There are 6 apples in the basket and grandma added 5 more. How many apples are there now?

- 8 Mary baked 6 pies for Thanksgiving. Her sister baked 7 pies. How many pies did they bake in total?

- 9 There are 12 chairs at the dining table. If 7 more chairs are added, how many chairs are there in total?
