

Compare Multiplication Expressions

Read the word problems and answer the questions by comparing the multiplication expressions .

1 Joshua bought 7 packs of 12 gummy bears. Joan bought 6 packs of 12 gummy bears. Who bought more gummy bears?

$$\begin{array}{ccc} \text{Joshua} & & \text{Joan} \\ 7 \times 12 & > & 6 \times 12 \end{array}$$

7 is greater than 6. This means Joshua has more gummy bears.

2 Herman read 2 books with 15 pages each on Monday. He then read 2 books with 10 pages each on Tuesday. On which day did he read more pages?

3 In the months of April and May, Amy did 5 sets of push-ups everyday. In which month did she do more sets of push ups?

4 Laura has 5 baskets of 3 bananas and 2 apples each. Lana has 5 baskets of 5 pears. Who has more fruits?

5 Nina drew 20 pictures on 5 pages each. Simone drew 30 pictures on 5 pages each. Who drew more pictures?

6 Rory has 2 bags of 5 potatoes and 3 bags of 6 cucumbers each. Johnny has 6 bags of 5 potatoes each. Who has more potatoes?
