- 6 A bakery baked 8,232 cookies. If they pack 8 cookies in each box, how many boxes will they need?
- 7 A clothing store received 5,679 shirts. If each rack can hold 9 shirts, how many racks were there?
- A book store has 4,564 books. If each shelf can hold 7 books, how many shelves does the store have?
