

# Fill in the Missing Numbers

Convert the mixed numbers into improper fractions by filling the blanks.

$$1 \frac{2}{3} = \frac{3 \times \square + 2}{3} = \frac{\square}{3}$$

$$2 \frac{3}{4} = \frac{4 \times \square + \square}{4} = \frac{\square}{\square}$$

$$4 \frac{1}{2} = \frac{\square \times 4 + \square}{\square} = \frac{\square}{\square}$$
