3 You are buying 2.5 pounds of rice, each pound costs \$1.85. How much will you pay?

4 A fruit stall sells a pound of strawberries for \$2.75. If a customer buys 3.5 pounds, how much will they pay?

5 A pool club charges \$3.50 per hour for renting a pool float. If a swimmer rents for 2.5 hours, how much will they need to pay?

6 A beach resort charges \$3.50 per hour for renting a kayak. If you rent a kayak for 2.5 hours, how much will you pay?

7 A fruit stand sells mangoes for \$1.50 per pound. If you buy 2.5 pounds of mangoes, how much will you pay?

8 A seller sells one litre of juice for \$2.75. If you want to buy 3.5 litres, how much will it cost?

9 A watermelon costs \$2.45 per pound. If you buy 3.5 pounds of watermelon for a party, how much will you pay?
