

Winter Multiplication

Solve the following word problems.

- John bought 5.5 pounds of salt to melt the ice on his driveway. If each bag of salt costs \$3, how much did he spend?
- 2 Emma bought 7 scarves for her friends. Each scarf costs \$4.75. How much did Emma spend in total?
- A snowplow clears 3.2 miles of road every hour. If it works for 8 hours, how many miles of road does it clear?
- 4 Each winter, a tree sheds 2.5 pounds of leaves. If there are 4 trees in the backyard, how many pounds of leaves do they shed?
- A hot chocolate packet costs \$1.25. If Peter buys 6 packets, how much does he spend?
- A ski resort sells day passes for \$45.5 each. If they sell 7 passes in a day, how much money do they make?
- 7 Each snowball weighs 0.4 pounds. If a child makes 5 snowballs, what is the total weight of the snowballs?
- A winter coat costs \$85.5. If a store sells 3 coats, how much money does the store make?
- A snowman is 4.5 feet tall. If there are 3 snowmen, what is their total height?
