

# Interpret Numerical Expressions

Place parentheses at the correct places to make the numerical interpretation correct.

Twelve divided by the product of three and four.

$$12 \div 3 \times 4$$

Ten multiplied by the difference of eight and four.

$$8 - 4 \times 10$$

Sum of two and fourteen divided by eight.

$$2 + 14 \div 8$$

Eighteen divided by the product of two and three

$$18 \div 3 \times 2$$

Seven multiplied by sum of eight and nine

$$7 \times 8 + 9$$
