- John traveled 9.5 miles on his bike and then 3.4 miles on foot. How many more miles did he travel on his bike than on foot?
- 2 A train traveled 45.6 miles in the morning and 39.2 miles in the afternoon. How many fewer miles did the train travel in the afternoon than in the morning?
- A tourist has \$50.5. He spent \$15.7 on souvenirs. How much money does he have left?
- 4 A plane flew 500.5 miles in the first hour and 499.7 miles in the second hour. How many fewer miles did the plane fly in the second hour?
- A cruise ship traveled 150.9 miles on Monday and 145.6 miles on Tuesday. How many fewer miles did the ship travel on Tuesday?
- 6 A hiker walked 12.7 miles in the morning and 11.2 miles in the afternoon. How many fewer miles did the hiker walk in the afternoon?
- 7 A bus traveled 75.5 miles in the first hour of its journey and 74.2 miles in the second hour. How many fewer miles did the bus travel in the second hour?
- A car can travel 120.6 miles on a full tank of gas. If we start driving on a full tank, after traveling 115.3 miles, how many miles can it still travel?
