- 1 For Thanksgiving, John bought a turkey that weighed 12.56 lbs and a ham that weighed 7.89 lbs. How much lighter was the ham than the turkey?
- The turkey weighed 14.65 pounds before cooking. After roasting, it weighed 11.92 pounds. What was the weight loss due to roasting?
- A Thanksgiving booth used 12.64 feet of ribbon for decorations but took down 6.45 feet. What is the remaining length of ribbon?
- The cost of a Thanksgiving dinner was \$45.75. If the dessert, priced at \$8.25, was removed, what was the total cost without dessert?
- During a fabric sale for Thanksgiving crafts, 27.65 yards were available, but 15.14 yards were sold. How much fabric remained unsold?
- The Thanksgiving pie contest had a grand prize of \$500.25. If the second place prize was \$275.32, how much less was the second place prize than the grand prize?
- During a corn maze at the fair, the first path was 15.32 feet long, and the second was 8.75 feet. What was the difference in length between the two paths?
