Solve the following word problems.

- 1 Bob bought 3.65 pounds of ice-melt salt and used 1.28 pounds to de-ice his driveway. How much ice-melt salt does he have left in pounds?

- 2 Samantha has 5.55 quarts of anti-freeze. If she uses 2.72 quarts for her car, how much anti-freeze will she have left in quarts?

- 3 A winter storm dropped 8.25 inches of snow. The sun melted 3.53 inches. How many inches of snow remained after melting?

- 4 A ski resort had 12.55 feet of snow. After a warm day, it reduced to 9.67 feet. How much snow melted in feet?

- 5 A thermos can hold 4.95 quarts of hot cocoa. If you drink 1.72 quarts, how much hot cocoa is left in the thermos in quarts?

- 6 A winter hat costs \$7.25. If you have a coupon for \$2.56 off, how much will the hat cost you in dollars?

- 7 A snowman was initially 5.76 feet tall. After some sun exposure, it shrank to 3.59 feet tall. How much did the snowman shrink in height in feet?

- 8 A ski resort has 15.25 miles of trails. After a blizzard, 2.72 miles of trails are closed. How many miles of trails are still open for use?
